The most enduring gift of all those has been our purpose; a deeply informed and radical philosophy of what radio and community media can be.

I'd like to thank the many presenters, with some programs that have been on air for decades. who remain as relevant today as they were when they started. Some left and returned because of the changes that were brought about by the board that was committed to bring about good change. But we are also evolving and growing with the challenges of our times, driven by the energy, politics and passion of our volunteers who turn up and do what they do, week in week out.
