GRANTS

Roy, Andsley and the team have been doing exceptionally well applying for grants and many applications have been accepted including:

- \$13,090 from CBF for ethnic broadcasting
- \$6,500 from Parramatta Leagues
- \$10,000 from Parramatta Council
- \$3,000 from Castle Hill RSL
- \$1,000 from Hills Council





This means we will have another busy year in 2023 fulfilling the requirements of the grants, but it certainly means wonderful improvements at the station.
